Anne was the best Mom, endlessly supportive with the answers to all of life's questions. She was a super Grandmom, indulging the kids with their imaginary games for hours on end. Anne was most happy surrounded by her loving family, telling stories and laughing.

Anne was an extraordinary woman and is dearly missed and forever loved by her daughter Jacqueline Spurrier (Daniel), grandchildren Zoey, Layla and Austin, mother Kathleen Connors, and the entire Connors clan of over 50 family members, including her 7
